All Saints & All Souls

Each November, the Church celebrates two feast days, which are related to each other. All Saints' Day is a solemnity celebrated on November 1st. On this day we celebrate the great Communion of Saints, which includes those holy men and women who have passed before us but have not been canonized. All Souls' Day is celebrated on November 2nd and is a day to remember and pray for all those who have died.

Though Halloween is a now a mostly secular annual holiday, it is historically connected to All Saints' and All Souls' Days. Halloween originated with a festival called Samhain, which was celebrated by the ancient Celts. Samhain was a day to celebrate the year's harvest and to honor the dead. As Christianity took hold in the ancient world, the autumnal observance of Samhain took on sacred meaning from the Church's celebration of All Saints' Day, which was originally celebrated in May.

Pope Gregory III designated November 1st to honor the saints. The night before was known as Eve of All Hallows. By the 7th century, these two ancient holidays were merged, making the Eve of All Hallows, later called "Halloween," a time to both acknowledge the passage into death and to celebrate those who have passed into Eternal Life.

While Christians have always prayed for the dead, All Souls' Day began in the 7th century when Odilo of Cluny established a day to pray and give alms for those in purgatory. Though it began as a local feast, by the 10th century it was a celebration spread throughout the Church. Today, Catholics celebrate All Saints' Day and All Souls' Days on November 1st and 2nd.

All Saints' Day is usually a Holy Day of Obligation. This year, however, because it falls on a Saturday, it is not. On All Saints' Day, we are attend Mass to praise and worship God and honor the lives of the saints. We celebrate all the saints, including those who are known and unknown. We are especially mindful of our patron saints: the saints whose names we share, those that our families honor, or that our schools or parishes are named.

On All Souls' Day, the Church prays for all those in purgatory. We may also remember those who have died by visiting the cemetery where they are buried, lighting a candle, attending Mass, giving alms, and doing good works.

We believe that we continue to share a relationship with those who have died. When we pray for the souls of the faithful departed, we are praying for those whose souls are journeying through purgatory, being prepared for eternal life in heaven. We believe that our prayers for them will help to speed their journey to eternal life with God in heaven.

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed All Souls Day

In today's Gospel we envision a crowd following Jesus, seeking him. He invites them to embrace faith in himself and his Father in heaven and share in their eternal life. He comes right out and says that no one who comes will be rejected, reminding us that even those who feel estranged from God or the Church are welcomed. Good stewards know that everyone can be raised up if they accept the Father's will, and in turn, use the gifts God has given them to further Christ's work. This promise gives us hope. The stewardship question is: Are we true seekers of the Lord? Do we genuinely desire a relationship with Christ? Are we willing to follow him?

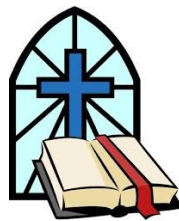

Today (November 2) begins Vocation Awareness Week. Please pray that young people in today's culture will hear and respond to God's call. And do your part to encourage them to consider the priesthood and consecrated life.

As Catholics, we firmly believe that God has a plan for our lives! He calls some to marriage, some to priesthood, and others to religious life or to live as generous single people. Fully living our own vocations-and teaching young people how to discern God's call-is a serious duty, but also a joyful one.

National Vocation Awareness Week was instituted by the U.S. Bishops in 1976, and is now celebrated the first week of November. This year, the beginning of the week falls on All Saints Day-a happy coincidence, because a vocation, in its fullest sense, is our path to heaven and sainthood.

During this week, please pray about how God is calling you to live your vocation more deeply. Encourage the young people in your life-children, grandchildren, students and friends-to be open if God calls them to priesthood or religious life.
